

12 Day Roads Less Travelled West Coast and Kgalagadi

Langebaan / Orange River / Namib Desert / Baobab Forest / Augrabies



Want something truly unique? Something few do but those that embark on the journey are handsomely rewarded? Well this itinerary is yours. From Cape Town along the forgotten roads of the West Coast where we overnight on the banks of the Langebaan Lagoon, a bird watchers paradise with many hides and an array of wader species and many endemic species as well. Our overnight on the meandering banks of the Orange river which we will see again later at the Mighty Roaring Augrabies Falls. The Namib Desert , Swakopmund and then South toward the Baobab Forest and Giants playground. The prime wildlife attraction is of course the Kgalagadi Transfrontier National Park.

Where the red dunes and scrub fade into infinity and herds of gemsbok, springbok, eland and blue wildebeest follow the seasons, where imposing camel thorn trees provide shade for huge black-maned lions and vantage points for leopard and many raptors... this is the Kgalagadi Transfrontier National Park. An amalgamation of the Kalahari Gemsbok National Park in South Africa (proclaimed in 1931) and the Gemsbok National Park in Botswana, the Kgalagadi Transfrontier Park comprises an area of over 3,6 million hectares – one of very few conservation areas of this magnitude left in the world.
